

In accordance with BCC-97 Section G.1 the agenda shall provide a section for public comment limited to thirty (30) minutes following approval of the consent agenda during each Regular County Commission Meeting. The purpose of public comment is to allow individuals to comment on any topic relating to County business which is not on the meeting agenda. Individuals delivering public comment shall be restricted to a three-minute time limit on their presentation. During this thirty (30) minute segment of public comment, speakers will be heard in the order in which they turned in a pink card asking to be heard. Any speaker not heard during the first thirty minute segment will be heard during a second public comment segment held at the conclusion of business specified on the regular Commission agenda. Individuals may not speak under both the first and second public comment period. With the exception of emergency items, the Board will take no action under the Public Comment section, but can refer the matter to another meeting agenda or request a staff report.

Any invocation that may be offered before the official start of the Commission meeting shall be the voluntary offering of a private citizen, to and for the benefit of the Commission. The views or beliefs expressed by the invocation speaker have not been previously reviewed or approved by the Commission, and the Commission is not allowed by law to endorse the religious beliefs or views of this, or any other speaker.

Adoption of a Resolution establishing user fees for FY 2022-2023 for the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District

### Requested Action:

It is requested by the Melbourne Tillman Water Control District that the Board of County Commissioners adopt the attached Resolution approving user fees for the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District for FY 2022-2023 and authorize the Chair to sign the Resolution.

## **Summary Explanation and Background:**

The user fees requested and recommended by the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District's Board of Directors represents a 1.05% increase in the FY 2022-2023 rates for Residential, a 4.69% increase for Commercial, and no increase in Agricultural due to the legislative cap on the agricultural classification. Proposed rates are as follows:

- Residential from \$24.74 per lot or acre to \$25.00
- Agriculture remains at \$8.50 per lot or acre
- Commercial from \$47.93 per lot or acre to \$50.18

Per Ch. 2001-336 Laws of Florida, the fee must be established by resolution of the Board of Directors and approved by a majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners, with each County Commissioner whose county commission residency area lies wholly or partially within the District (District 3 and District 5) voting in the affirmative.

#### RESOLUTION NO.2022-

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AND ADOPT USER FEES PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 2001-336, LAWS OF FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF THE MELBOURNE-TILLMAN WATER CONTROL DISTRICT TO LEVY USER FEES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 2001-336, Laws of Florida, provides the authority for the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District to levy user fees; and

WHEREAS, the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District is a dependent special district of the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners whose charges and budget are subject to the approval of the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the user fees proposed by the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District have been advertised and the subject of public hearings conducted by the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners on August 9, 2022; and August 16, 2022.

WHEREAS, the user fees to be levied represent a 1.05% increase over current rates for Residential, a 4.69% increase for Commercial and no increase in Agricultural due to the legislative cap on the agricultural classification, are stated in this resolution, and have been publicly read in full.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

1. The Board of Directors of the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District has adopted the following classifications (categories of land use) to be assessed as follows:

CLASSIFICATION I, RESIDENTIAL - \$25.00 per lot, acre or portion thereof

CLASSIFICATION II, AGRICULTURAL - \$8.50 per lot, acre or

portion thereof

CLASSIFICATION III, COMMERCIAL -

\$50.18 per lot, acre or

portion thereof

This levy has been adopted for the Budget of the District for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2022, and ending September 30, 2023.

- 2. The aforementioned classifications and fees of the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District are hereby ratified and affirmed for the Budget and Fiscal Year 2022-2023.
- 3. A certified copy of this Resolution shall be filed with the Tax Collector of Brevard County, Florida.
  - 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
