The Fair Housing Amendments Act protects the right of people with disabilities to keep emotional support animals, even when a landlord's policy explicitly prohibits pets. The law will generally require the landlord to make an exception to its "no pet" policy so that a tenant with a disability can fully use and enjoy his or her dwelling. In most housing complexes, so long as the tenant has a letter or prescription from an appropriate professional, such as a therapist or physician, he or she is entitled to a reasonable accommodation that would allow an emotional support animal in the apartment.
