9. (22V00030) Jerry G. and Lennie G. Ballard (John and Robin Karlovitch) request variances of Chapter 62, Article VI, Brevard County Code, as follows: 1.) Section 62-1334(5)(b), to permit a variance of 6.5 ft. from the required 15-ft. side (west) setback for an accessory structure; 2.) Section 62-1334(5)(b), to permit a variance of 13.2 ft. from the required 15-ft. side (east) setback for an accessory structure in an AU (Agricultural Residential) zoning classification. This request represents the applicants' request to legitimize two accessory structures have been in this configuration since 1972. They also state that the accessory structures were built by a previous owner. The first request equates to a 43% deviation to what the code allows. The second request equates to an 88% deviation to what the code allows. There are no variances to the accessory setback requirements in the immediate area. If the Board approves this variance, it may want to limit its approval as depicted on the survey provided by the applicant with a date of 04/22/2022.
