

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Bree Ehmer, a Melbourne native and 2023 graduate of West Shore Junior/Senior High School, is a junior forward on Catawba College women's soccer team in Salisbury, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Ehmer was honored as the 2025 Division II Conference Commissioners Association (D2CCA) Women's Soccer Ron Lenz National Player of the Year, becoming the first female student-athlete to earn a National Player of the Year honor in Catawba Athletics history; and

WHEREAS, Ehmer was also named a First Team All-American at forward, the D2CCA Southeast Region Player of the Year and South Atlantic Conference (SAC) Player of the Year after finishing her season with 20 goals, including seven game-winners, and six assists for a total of 46 points; and

WHEREAS, Ehmer, who was named the team's Most Valuable Player, helped lead the Catawba Indians to an undefeated regular season, sweeping the SAC regular season and conference tournament titles en route to the first top seed in the NCAA Southeast Regional in program history; and

WHEREAS, Ehmer also excelled in the classroom, earning a perfect 4.0 cumulative grade-point average through the spring 2025 semester in Sports Medicine, resulting in her being named the 2025 South Atlantic Conference Women's Soccer Scholar-Athlete of the Year and Catawba's Whitley Award winner for the Most Outstanding Junior or Senior in Sports & Health Sciences.
