Accomplishments or Work Product for 2025:

- Leveraged over \$3 million in grant awards received from the Tourist Development Council and Florida Commerce for construction of the Amphitheatre at Veterans Memorial Park.
- o Continued collaboration with the County on the Sea Ray Drive Bridge Project providing over \$1 million in deferred TIF funding to date towards project completion. Project is nearing completion.
- o Collaborated with Space Coast Area Transit on installation of new Bus Shelters.
- Continued administering the \$500,000 U.S. EPA Brownfield Community-Wide Assessment Grant through execution of Phase I and Phase II Environmental Site Assessments (ESAs) and conceptual planning activities for the SR 520 Commercial Core.
- Conducted a successful and well attended community input workshop on ideas and concepts for the future of SR 520.
- Held numerous discussions with individual developers, and corporations regarding the redevelopment of Merritt Square Mall, and Griffis Landing area.
- o Continued on collaboration with the County in the design phase of the South Courtenay Parkway Expansion in partnership with Brevard County. MIRA will contribute \$2 Million towards the project.
- o Facilitated numerous redevelopment projects on SR 520 and SR 3 that attracted eight national retailers and other local businesses.
- o Reviewed and made recommendations on 13 site plans, five rezonings, four variances, one landscape waiver request, and one development plan review.

Recommendations or Suggestions for the Board:

- Encourage Board members to continue learning about MIRA goals and objectives and become increasingly familiar with County codes and land development regulations to assist them in their function as a recommending body.
- o Continue to provide strategic support and leadership.
- o Communicate MIRA's mission and success stories throughout the community.
