A RESOLUTION BY THE BREVARD COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ADOPTING A WASTEWATER REUSE DISTRICT WITHIN BREVARD COUNTY PURSUANT TO BREVARD COUNTY ORDINANCE 85-34

WHEREAS, diminishing supplies of good quality water resources and the rapidly escalating costs of treatment of both potable water and wastewater have underscored the necessity for water conservation practices as well as the reuse of water; and

WHEREAS, the reuse of properly treated wastewater for irrigation of lawns and landscaping not only conserves potable water supplies for potable water uses, but also reduces the amount of groundwater withdrawn for irrigation, which can lead and has led to saltwater intrusion in certain locations; and

WHEREAS, the use of reclaimed wastewater for irrigation purposes provides a viable means of wastewater disposal, converting what was traditionally considered a waste product into a valuable resource; and,

WHEREAS, the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners wishes to designate reuse districts within Brevard County where the establishment and operation of a reclaimed wastewater system is considered viable; and

WHEREAS, the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners is authorized to designate wastewater reuse districts pursuant to Brevard County Ordinance 85-34.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

1. South Central Mainland Wastewater Reuse District: Brevard County hereby establishes the South Central Mainland Wastewater Reuse District as described in Exhibit A, which is herein attached and incorporated by reference.

2. The provision of reclaimed water service and the operation of a reclaimed water system within this designated Reuse District shall be in compliance with the provisions set forth in Brevard County Ordinance 85-34 and amendments thereto.

Reuse District for the new South Central Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant to be located in the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 18, Township 26 South, Range 36 East adjacent to the Wickham Road Extension.

Areas listed by Township, Range and Section, less those portions lying within city limits and/or serviced by municipal or privately owned, operated, and maintained sewer systems:

Township 24 South, Range 34 East, Sections 29, 30, 31, 32 south of SR 520.

Township 25 South, Range 36 East, Sections 6, 7, 17, 18, 19 (east of I-95) and 20, 22, 23 (south of Barnes Boulevard), 26, 27, 28, 29, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36.

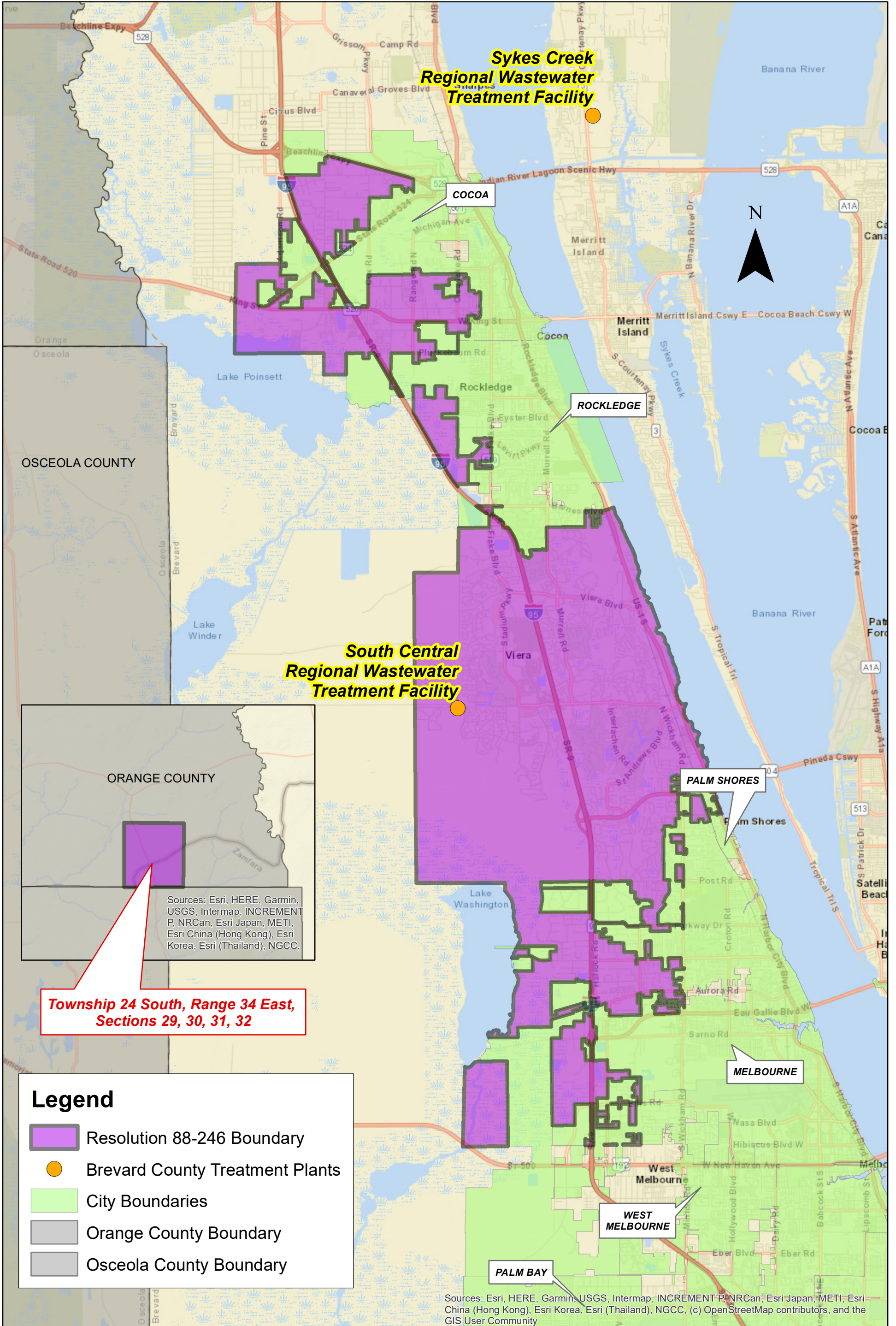
Township 26 South, Range 36 East, Sections 1 through 36.
