WHEREAS, over the next six decades, Ron Jon Surf Shop expanded into a world-wide phenomenon; and

WHEREAS, Ron with his wife Lynne, founded Surfing's Evolution & Preservation Foundation, a 501(c)(3) charitable organization that supports missions to protect the health of Florida's beaches and address issues such as coastal pollution and beach ecology and through the sale of the Endless Summer® specialty license plate, the Foundation financially supports programs, events and activities that impact protection for future generations to enjoy; and

WHEREAS, the <u>New York Times</u> wrote that Ron was a key figure in surfing's expansion into mainstream culture with a life said to be the stuff of folklore; and

WHEREAS, Ron DiMenna's vison and legacy will live on for generations through Ron Jon Surf Shop and Surfing's Evolution & Preservation Foundation.
