Re: Adoption of the Brevard County's proposed Appendix to the Potable Water Element (updated Water Supply Facilities Work Plan) and related text amendments.

Dear Mr. Stansbury:

Please find enclosed the Comprehensive Plan Amendment Adoption Package (Amendment No. 24-01ACSC) for the proposed Appendix to the Potable Water Element relating to the updated Water Supply Facilities Work Plan and related text amendments to ensure consistency with the Comprehensive Plan.

Section 163.3177(6)(c)(4), Florida Statutes requires local governments to update their Water Supply Facilities Work Plan, every 5 years within 18 months after the governing board of a water management district approves an updated regional water supply plan.

This amendment was subject to State Coordinated Review process pursuant to Section 163.3184(4), Florida Statutes. The following statements are included to ensure consistency with the statutory requirements contained therein.

- This amendment is related to the Brevard Barrier Island Area, an Area of Critical State Concern adopted pursuant to Section 380.0553, Florida Statutes.
- This amendment is not related to a rural land stewardship area pursuant to Section 163.3248, Florida Statutes.
- This amendment is not related to a sector plan pursuant to Section 163.3245, Florida Statutes.
- This amendment is not related to an update of the Comprehensive Plan based on an Evaluation and Appraisal Report pursuant to Section 163.3191, Florida Statutes.
- This amendment does not propose a development pursuant to Section 380.06, Florida Statutes

The adopted Comprehensive Plan amendment will incorporate the updated Water Supply Facilities Work Plan into the Potable Water Element as an appendix. The WSFWP includes the data and analysis on which the plan was developed and is shown as Exhibit A of the adoption ordinance. There are Comprehensive Plan text amendments to the goals, objectives and policies of the Conservation, Potable Water, Sanitary Sewer, Intergovernmental Coordination, Capital Improvements Elements, as well as, additions to the Glossary. These text amendments are shown in Exhibit B of the adoption ordinance and are required to implement the WSFWP and ensure internal consistency of the Comprehensive Plan.
