Comments from the public, if any, must precede actions to accept or amend the budget for County agencies, Charter Officers and Dependent Special Districts as summarized: County agencies of \$1,568,439,191, Charter Officers of \$181,243,176 and Dependent Special Districts of \$99,423,457. The total Tentatively approved County Operating and Capital Budget for FY 2022-2023 is \$1,849,105,824.

PROCLAMATION FOR 111TH NATIONAL DAY OF THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA (TAIWAN)

WHEREAS, The Republic of China (Taiwan) observes the 111th National Day on October 10th, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. and Taiwan have maintained close friendship based on the 1979 Taiwan Relations Act (Public Law 96-8 96th Congress), the cornerstone of U.S.-Taiwan ties which celebrates its 43rd anniversary in 2022; and

WHEREAS, Taiwan is the U.S.' 8th largest trading partner as well as the 11th largest export market and 8th largest import market, with two-way trade totaling \$114 billion in 2021. Taiwan is also Florida's 7th largest market in Asia as of 2021; and
