

City of Titusville	Evergreen	Use, maintain and operate 8 City owned parks with 1 City owned community center. Termination clause, 90 days notice to remove parks or by mutual agreement.
Brevard County School Board	10/9/33	Mutually beneficial agreement for use and maintenance of 12 school board owned properties. Termination clause, 12 month notice by either party.






