AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, CREATING A NEW ARTICLE IN CHAPTER 46 OF THE BREVARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES; SPECIFICALLY CREATING CHAPTER 46, ARTICLE XI, ENTITLED "LANDSCAPE IRRIGATION"; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION OF THE WATER CONSERVATION RULE FOR LANDSCAPE IRRIGATION OF THE ST.
