Dear Mr. Lober:

As provided by the terms of the Project Cooperation Agreement dated April 20, 2000 between the Department of the Army and Brevard County, Florida, for the Brevard County, Florida Shore Protection Project (Project), Brevard County, as the Non-Federal Sponsor, shall acquire all lands, easements, and rights-of-way required for the periodic nourishment, as set forth in such descriptions. This letter serves as the Government's request for these real property interests to be certified for the Project.

The real property interests required are located between Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) reference monuments R-30 and R-054.5, as shown in the enclosed map (Enclosure 1), and further described below:

a. Beach Storm Damage Reduction Easements for a term of 50 years for the Beach Fill Areas located landward of the Erosion Control Line (ECL).

b. Sovereign Submerged Lands Authorization contained within the Joint Coastal Permit for the Beach Fill Areas located seaward of the ECL.

c. Temporary Work Area Easement for a minimum of 24 months for the Staging area.

d. Temporary Work Area Easements for a minimum of 24 months for the three Access areas.

Enclosed are templates for the Certification of Lands (Enclosure 2), Attorney's Certificate of Authority (Enclosure 3) and the required language for the Beach Storm Damage Reduction Easement and the Temporary Work Area Easements (Enclosure 4). Please provide the signed Land Certification, the signed Attorney's Certificate, and all supporting documents by July 17, 2020 via email to hansler.a.bealyer@usace.army.mil.
